OSHA Is Plenty Alive

- New "Improve Tracking of Workplace Injuries and Illnesses" Rule (under challenge and revision)
- New Silica Standard (delayed; *defunded*?)
- New Beryllium Standard (delayed)
- New Walking/Working Surfaces Standard (alive and well)

OSHA Is Plenty Alive

- Multiple "interpretations"/changes of interpretation
 - Hearing conservation (withdrawn)
 - Walk-around representatives (withdrawn)
 - PSM retail exemption (struck down by court)
 - Safety incentive programs (under challenge)
- Recordkeeping statute of limitations –
 Volks (struck down by Congress)

New Maximum Penalty Amounts Effective January 1, 2018

- Serious/Other-than-Serious \$12,934 (up from \$12,675)
- Willful/Repeat \$129,336 (up from \$126,770)
- Failure to Abate \$12,934 per day (up from \$12,675 per day)

The New OSHA - In General

- Supposedly much more conservative
- Supposedly likely to reverse interpretations
- Likely to "undo" new standards/rules
- Unlikely to "undo" old standards/rules, at least completely
- Not likely to publish (m)any new standards
- "Two-for-one" Executive Order January 30, 2017

- Recent activity
 - Fall Agenda removed many notable Obama/ Michaels items
 - Hazard Communication Standard Update (proposed)
 - Combustible Dust (pre-rule)
 - Bloodborne Pathogens (pre-rule)
 - Backover Injuries/Fatalities (pre-rule)
 - Emergency Response/Preparedness (pre-rule)
 - Hearing Protection Update (pre-rule)

- Recent activity
 - Fall Agenda pulled back on other Obama/Michaels item
 - Tracking of Workplace Injuries/Illnesses ("Electronic Recordkeeping") (proposed)

Recent activity

- Spring Agenda
 - Tracking of Workplace Injuries/Illnesses ("Electronic Recordkeeping") (projected for July 2018)
 - Request for information on updating Lockout/Tagout Standard (projected June 2018)
 - New tree care industry standard (SBREFA April 2019)
 - New workplace violence standard for health care (SBREFA) January 2019)

How about reversing Obama OSHA's internal penalty enhancements?

Example	"Summed Up"	"Serially"
GBP	\$12,000	\$12,000
History (-10%)		\$12,000 -10%
Good Faith (-20%)		\$10,800 -20%
Quick Fix (-15%)		\$8,640 -15%
Size (-30%)	10%+15%=15%+30%=-75%	\$7,344 -30%
Penalty Issued	\$3,000	\$5,142

The New OSHA – Still Old For A While

- Truth
 - Bureaucracies are run by bureaucrats
 - Policy change takes a while to "trickle down"
 - HQ v. Regions v. Areas
- Consequences: Lots of inertia and lag time
- Result: More of the same in the field for a while

Inspections Conducted FY 2010 - FY 2017





% Programmed vs. % Unprogrammed Inspections FY 2010 - FY 2017











Severe Injury Reports

Hospitalizations Amputations CY 2015








Severe Injury Reports

CY 2017: 11,884 Reports 30% (3560) Inspection / 70% (8324) RRI










% Inspections without Resulting Citations FY 2010 - FY 2017

% Total Citation Items Issued As Serious FY 2010 - FY 2017










% Total Citation Items Issued as Serious, Willful, or Repeat FY 2010 - FY 2017









Average Current Penalty per Serious **Alleged Violation** \$3,645 \$3,500 \$3,000 \$2,455 \$2,211 \$2,500 \$2,133 \$2,153 \$2,046 \$1,897 \$2,000 \$1,500 \$1,053 \$1,000

Note: Increased maximum OSHA penalties went into effect August 2, 2016 in compliance with the 2015 Inflation Adjustment Act.

Penalties









- New Silica Standard General Industry/ Construction
- New Walking-Working Surfaces Standard
- Novel Cases
- Combustible Dust NEP

- New Respirable Crystalline Silica Standard
 - Comprehensive standard establishes 8-hour timeweighted average, permissible exposure limit (PEL) of 50 μ g/m³, and action level of 25 μ g/m³
 - Effective enforcement dates stepped
 - Legal challenge failed


- New Silica Standard
 - Interim enforcement guidance published
 - CPL, FAQs, letters of interpretation in process
 - Enforcement in construction effective September 23, 2017
 - Enforcement in general industry effective June 23, 2018

- New Walking-Working Surfaces Standard
 - *Very* comprehensive
 - In the works for 20+ years
 - Effective January 17, 2017
 - Exceptions: training, rope descent anchorage inspections, some ladder requirements
 - Some requirements grandfathered for existing installations (e.g., height of stair rails)
 - Training requirements effective May 17, 2017
 - OSHA developing FAQs, CPLs

- Combustible Dust NEP
 - One of nine NEPs
 - Proposed changes
 - New targeting based on 10 years of experience
 - More technical guidance for CSHOs
 - Experience requirement for CSHOs
 - 476 total inspections in CY17, 319 resulting in citations, including under:
 - Walking-Working Surfaces Standard
 - General Duty Clause

- "Novel Cases"
 - All under General Duty Clause
 - Types
 - Workplace violence
 - Ergonomics
 - Heat
 - Two kinds of results
 - Citations
 - Hazard Alert letters (HALs)
