ERGONOMIC KAIZEN

SIMPLE SOLUTIONS THAT HAVE POSITIVE IMPACTS ON SAFETY

Through education and principles to create a safety culture to reduce risk and have fun!

- Education
 - To identify a problem:
 - Ergonomics
 - 5S/Housekeeping
 - Motion Waste
 - Brainstorming Solutions
 - Train the Trainer to hold Kaizen Events
 - ERGO Risk Assessment
- ERGO Principles
 - Is it too high or too low?
 - Is it out of reach?
 - Is it awkward?





CROSS FUNCTIONAL TEAMS

TEAMS HAD EMPLOYEES FROM DIFFERENT AREAS AND SKILLS

Cross functional teams were created to help outside the box thinking!

- Two teams were created at each event that consisted of hourly operations, salaried employees and maintenance. Engineers even joined our events!
- Enabling and Encouraging Employees.
- "Find it Fix it Mentality".
- All employees engaged in the brainstorming activity to find solutions.





COLLABORATION

MULTIPLE SITES COLLABORATED

Sites collaborated both hourly and salary to support each event.

- On average 3 employees two hourly and one salary went supported another site between Elwood, Las Vegas and Shelby sites.
- Teams were comprised of all sites and different work areas (operations and maintenance).


 Areas that held events were converting operations, distribution, and paper machine operations.

COST TO IMPLEMENT

PARTNERED WITH THIRD PARTY TO FACILITATE


Invested to reduce risk through identification, collaboration, education, and empowering employees. One event had a total savings of **4228 steps** per day! That's an average of about **2 miles**!





- All 4 Kaizen Events Average
- % of Improvements ≥\$10

66% of Improvements ≤ 15 minutes



- 23 Elwood & 23 Shelby Kaizen Events
- Time over 15 minutes

Total reduction of 326 fixes that made it better today than yesterday!

GLUE TOTE RELOCATION



PROBLEM

Glue tote too far from point of use.



SOLUTION

- Relocated glue tote closer to point of use.
- Cost: Free
- Time to Complete: 15 minutes
- Benefit: 80 steps saved per day, 560 steps per week, 29,120 steps per year. 56 hours saved per year.

PALLET HANDLING

2023 LAS VEGAS KAIZEN EVENT

PVOH Pallet Handling





x Bending down to lift 51.115 lbs. bag of PVOH chemical.



- ✓ Getting a Spring lift table to handle the pallet.
- It has two more option for safety: Accordion skirting & solid desc cover to prevent build up debris and control any kind of pallets.

✓ \$5k



- ✓ Getting a hydraulic lift table to handle the pallet.
- ✓ Decrease the time as it level up with the table.
- √ \$5k
- √ Reduce back pain ergonomics.











PALLET HANDLING

2023 LAS VEGAS KAIZEN EVENT

Poly Handling





Poly rolls were too low (c= 14") when prepping a poly change.






- ✓ Create a table of poly wrapped pallets to a more userfriendly height (C=46") to eliminate back bending.
- ✓ Straighten up the back while processing.
- √ \$10
- ✓ Saved time and less steps.

FACIAL CARTON REDESIGN

2024 LAS VEGAS KAIZEN EVENT

Facial- Cartoner Reconfiguration



x Moving elephant guard to accommodate new cartoner loading configuration. Modify platform for more ergofriendly loading of cartons

Collaborated with Graphics Packaging to find solutions! Operators say best \$1300 spent!

Ball conveyor: \$193 Material (Steel): \$1,050 New Wheels: \$ 75

- √ In progress
- ✓ Increased the height of the table.
- √ Added roller ball conveyor
- Moved the platform and stairs to reduce awkward position and lifting of the cartons.
- Cartons are able to slide from pallet to conveyor to loading area.










LINE 4, WINDER



- x Employees bending over to ground level to pick up cores from core machine
- x Bending over multiple times per shift

This was a reapplication at other sites from an event!



- Added core bin on back side of machine to capture cores at waist height- Fabricated in house
- Employees no longer bend over to the ground
- ✓ Less than 1 hour to install after fabrication
- Reapplication opportunity on 6 lines




REAPPLICATION

REAPPLICATION FROM SITE TO SITE

Each site was able to learn and reapply from site to site.

- All fixes were shared to reapply to other areas of the mills as well as other sites.
- This process can not only be practiced at Clearwater Paper but can be used throughout the industry.





NEXT STEPS

CONTINUE ERGO KAIZEN EVENTS

Support sites to continue conducting Ergo Kaizen Events and to expand to other sites and board side of business.

- Cultivate additional support with hourly and salary positions with multi-site engagement during events.
- Continue to conduct ergonomic training for ergonomic risk assessments and train the trainer to help lead additional ergo kaizen events.
- Variety of "Find it fix it solutions" had long term solutions identified for permanent fixes (hard piped chemical instead of manual bucket loading, permanent stairs added, ect).

Expand the kaizen events and other ergonomic training to other Clearwater Paper

sites.
