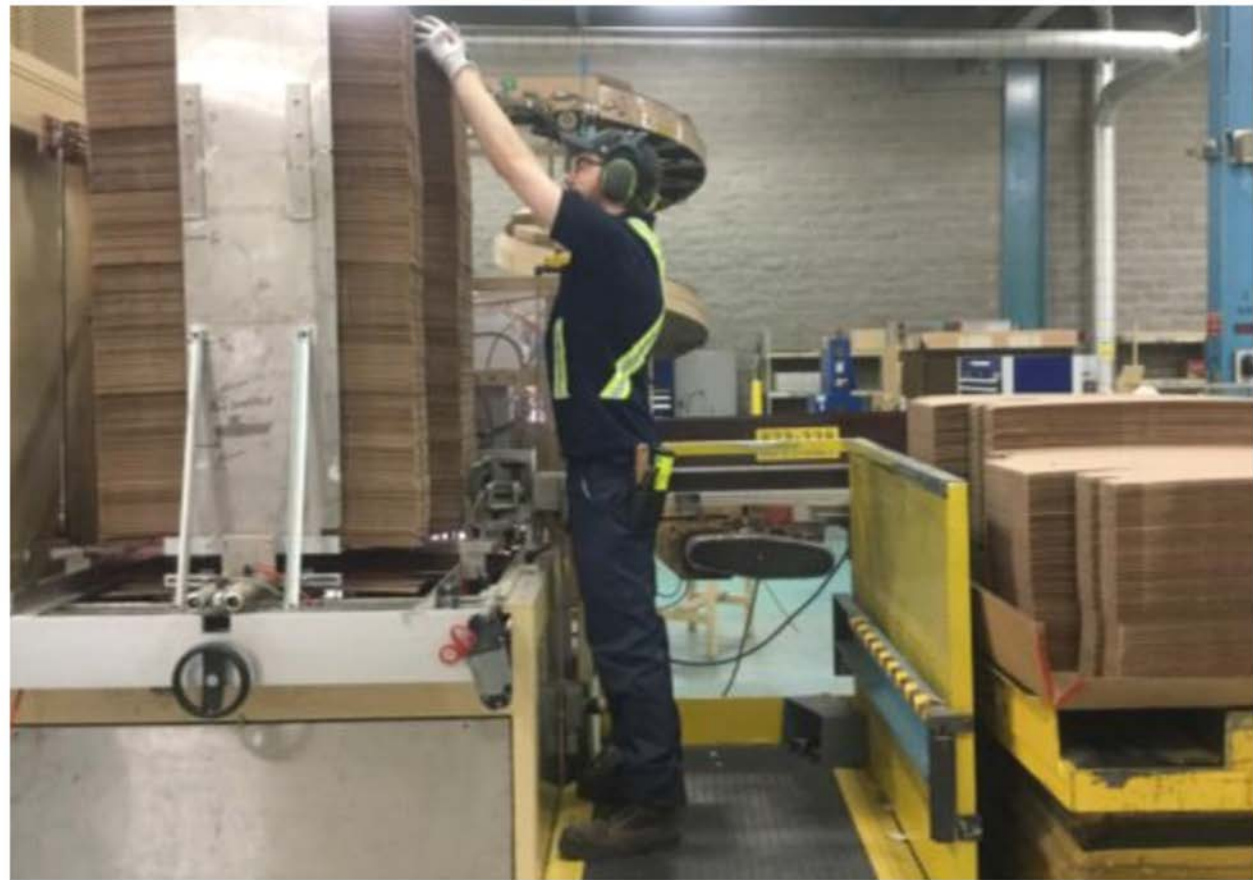


LIFTING TABLE TO LOAD CARDBOARD IN THE FEED BIN

BEFORE :

- Workers had to load sheets of cardboard in the feed table of the case packer, mounted on a fixed work platform (about 16 inches high)
- They raised their arms in extension over their shoulders.
- This motion was repeated until the packer's feed table store is full and is done again every 40 minutes.

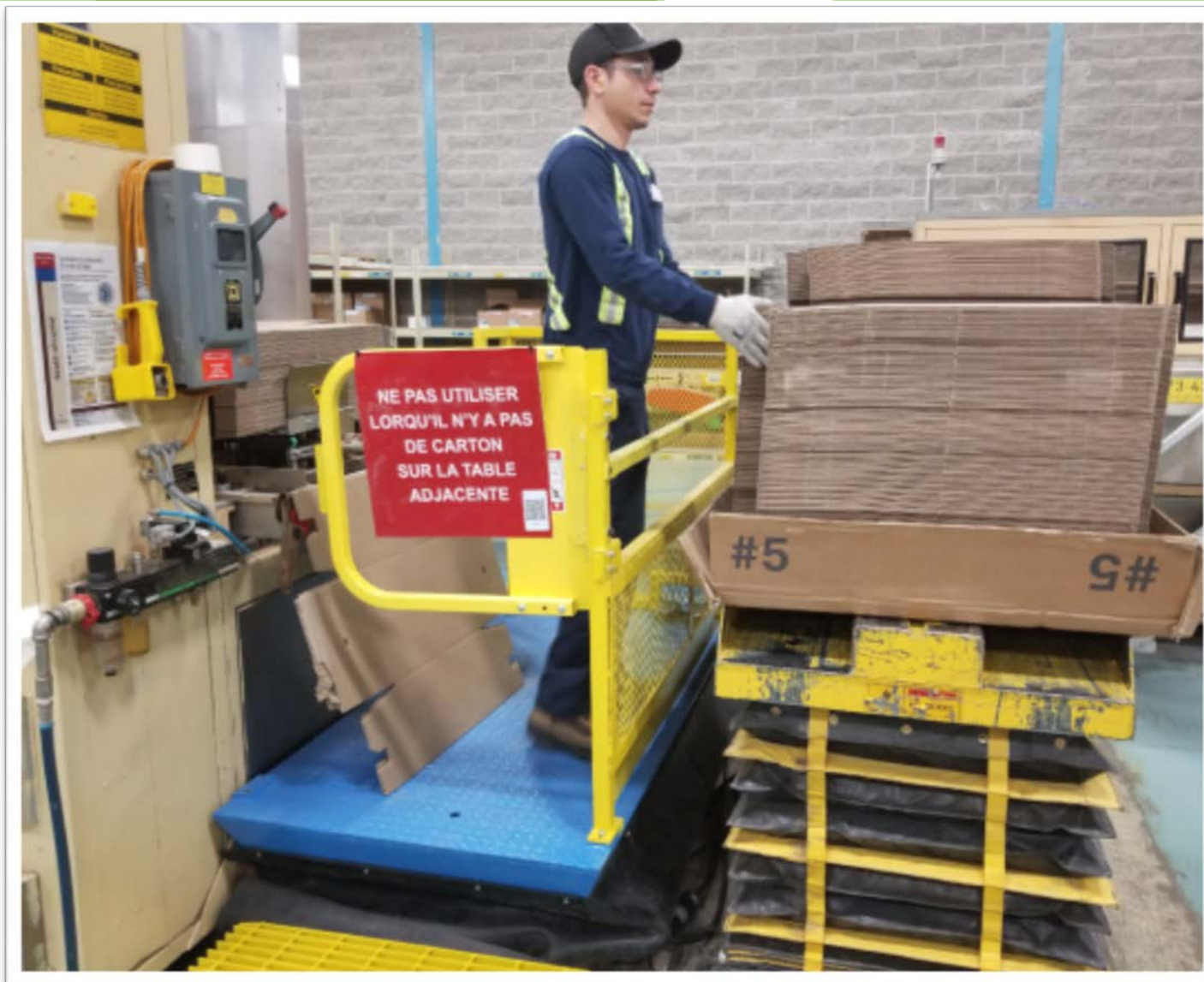
AFTER :

- The workers adapted a lift table to lift the operator to an ergonomic position which makes it easy to adjust the working height according to the height of the cardboard stack and the size of the worker.
- This greatly reduces the risk of shoulder pain because the worker is better positioned when loading the cardboard feed table and reduces the risk of falling during this operation.
